

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Every process is based on a goal. I am also happy to help you with your foreign language objectives in the form of individual consultations, which do not involve any commitment.

What platform is used for education?

Lessons take place on Zoom.

Do you only teach online?

No. Lessons can be held online or in person.

How many hours do I have to pay in advance?

You can buy private lessons in monthly packages. The number of the lessons is up to you.

Can I pay in arrears?

No. Tuition fees must always be paid in advance, before the unpaid lesson!

How long is a lesson?

A lesson may last 45 / 60 minutes or, in individual cases, may be agreed upon.

What happens if I cancel the class?

Cancellation is possible 24 hours before the scheduled time. In this case, there are no consequences. In this case, the hourly rate can be carried forward. However, in case of cancellation within 24 hours, the class will be considered as cancelled and the fee will be charged!

What happens if I am late?

The 45/ 60-minute time slot is for the booked lesson that I am available for. If you are late, I am not obliged to keep the lesson longer, but I will charge you the full lesson fee.

Are the lessons held at fixed times?

It is in our common interest to have fixed dates, so I prefer fixed dates! Of course, this is not always possible, so it is also possible to arrange variable dates.

Will I receive an invoice for the payment?

Yes, of course! My company operates under Hungarian law, and is registered in Hungary.

Important: *I can only issue invoices to individuals. I am unable to service corporate invoice requests due to the way the business is taxed.*
